The European Commission has supported the establishment of the European University of Technology within the European Universities Initiative since 2020.

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AT HOME IN EUROPE

EUT+ is continuously intensifying collaboration in teaching – through joint courses, new and more mobility options, the introduction of joint study programmes and degrees. By 2030, 90 percent of all EUT+ students should make use of at least one mobility window. Several study programmes already provide for inter-campus mobility, e.g. Industrial Engineering, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Architecture, Telecommunications & Networks.



DOING RESEARCH TOGETHER

The nine EUT+ universities are successively expanding their collaboration in research through numerous cross-university projects and the establishment of joint institutes for research and teaching.



The European Culture and Technology Laboratory (ECT Lab+)

The ECT Lab+ is the first European Research Institute established by the EUT+ alliance and an important element of the European University of Technology. As a transdisciplinary collaborative facility, the ECT Lab+ conducts cutting-edge research and explores in depth the nature and function of technology. Its objective is to define and promote a specific European model around technology while helping legal and regulatory frameworks to evolve in the right direction.

The alliance is currently in the process of establishing further EUT+ European Research Institutes, including the Data Science Lab, the Sustainability Lab and EUTINN, where nanomaterial and nanotechnology researchers are pooling their expertise.
