Introduction

The h_da and eight partner universities are working together on the vision of a new type of university - the European University. Since 2020, the EU Comission has been promoting the goal of growing together to form the "European University of Technology" (EUT+). The aim of the alliance is to contribute to the further integration of Europe as one of the first technology-oriented European universities. The partners will strenghten and intensify cooperation at all levels in the areas of teaching, research and transfer.

The h_da together with the partners want to become better and more cosmopolitan universites. We are growing together step by step: initially through joint teaching modules, better recognition of academic achievements and research cooperation. Later, joint European degree programs and much more will be added. Students will benefit from simplified mobility and the acquisition of intercultural skills, among other things. Researchers will have more opportunities for joint projects and employes will have more chances for international encounters. At the end, the universities will merge into one European university. Across Europe, EUT+ is one of about 50 university alliances that are the first to strive, along with their eight partner universities, to establish a common transnational university institution with campuses spanning from Western to Eastern Europe.

9 UNIVERSITIES, 100.000 STUDENTS, ONE GOAL

Our goals

All partner universities are united by a focus on technology that does not lose sight of the needs of people and the environment. Our cooperation is deepening bit by bit in many areas. For example, new joint projects in the area of research are continually emerging. In the first year of the initiative, the participating universities have already raised around 10 million euros in funding of which 1.8 million euros are allocated to h_da. For the second phase, EUT+ has a total of an additional 14.4 million euros available.

There are also intial collaborations in teaching, for example in the form of lectures that are open to all EUT+ students. There are also plans to dovetail the administrations - a first visible result will be a uniform campus card that will give students access to rooms at each EUT+ location, for example. We also plan the introduction of joint degrees in engineering —marking the beginning of further European study programs. Additionally, we aim to achieve that by 2030, ninety percent of all students participate in at least one mobility exchange.

Together we will:

- + Strengthen the European idea.
- + Exemplify equality and inclusion.
- + Improve the quality of our teaching.
- + Increase the quality and visibility of our research.
- + Make our university more diverse and inclusive.
- + Create a more efficient university administration.
- + Become more culturally diverse.
- + Design a new, European governance structure.
- + Create incentives for exchange.
- + Promote engagement and knowledge exchange.

Universities will grow together step by step. This will also require changes to European and national law.

EUT+ Phase II (2023 - 2024) The structure of work packages

The work to achieve the objectives has been organized into eleven different work packages. These work packages have been designed to form a closely interconnected framework of "pillars" and "cross-cutting blocks" that integrate and mutually reinforce each other to achieve the main goal of EUT+: the creation of a new model of a European university to address societal challenges sustainably and equitably.
