



Keep distance

- Wherever possible, a distance of 1.5 meters from other persons should be ensured.
- The summer semester 22 will take place as a complete attendance semester without corona-specific restrictions on room capacities. It will therefore often not be possible to ensure compliance with the minimum distance.
- Parallel to the presence teaching, many (administrative) activities will also have to be performed increasingly on site, so that a higher concentration of people will again be required in the area of workplaces.
- Working time regulations and the „Dienstvereinbarung zAhA“ should be used to ensure that no more than one person works per 10 m² of floor space in multi-person offices.



Masks

- The university management strongly recommends wearing a mask in university buildings, especially where the above-mentioned distance cannot be kept. Because masks are no longer mandatory, wearing an FFP2 mask is particularly appropriate because only this provides true self-protection.
- This can be dispensed with if...
 - ... there is only one person in the room, or
 - ... at a fixed seat in a meeting room where the distance of 1.5 m is ensured for all persons attending, and this room has a "good ventilation situation" (automatic ventilation system or ensuring window ventilation by means of a CO₂ monitoring system)
 - ... the speakers in a course maintain a distance of 1.5 meters from other persons in the audience.



Hygiene

- Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly with soap - at least 20 seconds!
- If there is no possibility to wash your hands: Use hand disinfection - let it work for 30 seconds!
- Observe coughing and sneezing etiquette:
 - ☞ turn away from others!
 - ☞ cough/sneeze in the crook of your arm or
 - ☞ use disposable tissues!



Entry restriction

- **Stay home if you show signs of illness!**
- **The university point out the legal regulations on isolation (for infected persons) and quarantine (for persons after contacts with increased risk of infection), which apply in general and therefore also within Darmstadt University of Applied Sciences.**
- **Report a Corona infection to the university!**



Ventilation

- **Ensure regular air exchange!**
- **In rooms with ventilation systems, the air exchange takes place automatically.**
- **In rooms without ventilation systems, cross-ventilate at least every hour!**
 - **Multi-person offices only with CO2 monitor: ventilate at the latest from 1,000 ppm!**
 - **Meeting/teaching rooms only with CO2 signal colour lights: ventilate at the latest when the display turns to yellow!**
