If you have symptoms of illness, please stay at home and contact your family doctor by phone! If you fall ill with COVID-19 within three days of attending the university, please report this to <u>pandemie@h-da.de</u> with details of your university contacts.

In suspicious cases, employees of the university may expel external persons from the campus for health reasons.

Access to university buildings is only permitted to persons who have been vaccinated, have recovered or have currently tested negative.

No entry

Persons who have tested positive for the Corona virus in the last ten days or have had contact with an increased risk of infection are not allowed to enter the university. If this is seven days in the past, the university may be entered after a negative test has been presented.

Persons who have entered the university from a high-risk area in the last ten days may not enter the university unless they provide the university with proof of a complete vaccination or recovery status. For persons who have entered from a virus variant area, the entry ban applies without restriction for 14 days.



Keep at least 1.5 metres distance from other people - this applies in front of buildings, on the traffic routes in buildings and in rooms.

Only use lifts individually (exception building C10: here max. two persons)!



You must wear a FFP2-mask in the university buildings.

When you are alone in a room or at your seat during a meeting - provided that the room is well ventilated and a distance of 1.5 m is maintained - you may remove the mask.



Observe the maximum number of persons in toilets and other signposted rooms!



After entering the university and reaching your destination: first of all, wash your hands thoroughly! Repeat regularly if necessary.



Keep your hands out of your face!



Follow the rules of etiquette for coughing and sneezing:

Keep your distance, turn away from others, hold the inside of your elbow in front of your mouth and nose.



Avoid large crowds on campus!
